1. Introduction

AAA is an easy, quick and powerful tool for keeping and managing text notes. You can hide/show it with a simple click on its icon in the Notification Area. AAA can store a history of the Clipboard of Windows, it can calculate statistics and it features multi-clipboard, alarms, sorting, text aligning and formatting, application starting... and much much more!

2. Licence

AAA is licenced under the Creative Commons Attribution - NonCommercial - NoDerivatives 4.0 International Licence (CC BY-NC-ND 4.0). To view a copy of the licence, please visit:

3. System requirements

AAA works under 32 or 64 bit Windows operating systems (version XP SP3 or later) and does not need any specific hardware resource apart.

4. How to install

AAA does not need any installation: just unzip and run it!

To upgrade an old version (5.0.0 or later): close AAA (if it is running) and overwrite the old files with the new ones. All the settings and data of AAA will be kept.

It is also possible (and highly advisable) to create a shortcut to the AAA.exe file where you like best and to set the icon in the Notification Area as always visible.

On obsolete Windows versions you may need to retrieve and install the Microsoft® .NET Framework 4 from the Microsoft official website:

5. How to use

Context menu: the icon in the Notification Area, the tab-strip, the text-boxes and the alarms have their own pop-up menu, showing their related options.

Command line parameters:

Parameter		Function
/?	/h	shows the “About AAA” window in English;
/?:eo	/h:eo	shows the “About AAA” window in Esperanto;
/?:it	/h:it	shows the “About AAA” window in Italian;
/m		starts AAA minimized into the Notification Area;
/nocheck		disables check for updates.

The parameters are case insensitive. Any other parameter will be ignored.

All the other options and operations should be self-explanatory... if they were not, volunteers are welcome to write down a more comprehensive user manual!

6. How to uninstall

Close AAA (if needed), delete its folder and any shortcut you created. That will completely uninstall AAA. :-)

If you had to install [.NET Framework 4](#), you may remove it through the usual “Add/Remove” applet of the Control Panel (be careful: it may be shared with other applications).

7. Feedback, suggestions, bug-reports

It is advisable to specify “AAA” in the subject field and to report the version of both the program and the operating system.

AAA is a multilingual application: contact me if you are willing to translate it into another language!

8. Release history

- Version **5.4.3** — January 1st, 2020
 - AAA may reload its data file if it has been externally modified.
 - Restored management of fonts and background colours in the “Alarms” window.
- Version **5.4.2** — November 11th, 2019
 - Added save and restore AAA position in “Options” menu.
 - Removed “AAA Always Alive”.
- Version **5.4.1** — November 11th, 2018
 - Added the restarter “AAA Always Alive”.
- Version **5.4.0** — June 21st, 2018
 - Added a global (customised) keyboard shortcut to show and hide AAA.
 - Added automatic replacement of parts of text in the Clipboard of Windows.
 - Modified the behaviour of “Show AAA”: the window is immediately shown even if it was previously minimized.
 - Bug fixed: getting some kind of non-textual data from the Clipboard of Windows could freeze AAA.
 - Minor cosmetic changes.
- Version **5.3.3** — January 19th, 2018
 - Bug fixed: Visual Studio automatically enlarged each menu icon of AAA.
- Version **5.3.2** — January 1st, 2018
 - Minor cosmetic changes.
- Version **5.3.1** — December 21st, 2017
 - Added a “Delay” field in the “Application starter” window to be applied while starting groups of applications.
 - Replaced ReadMe.EN.txt with this ReadMe.EN.pdf (nicely typeset with L^AT_EX) and accordingly redesigned the “About AAA” window.

- Bug fixed: multi-clipboard recognised new lines in Microsoft format only.
 - Bug fixed: geometric mean in the “Analyse numbers” window could return infinity when evaluated on many large numbers.
 - Changed format of versioning, adopting the usual scheme: major.minor.revision.
 - Minor cosmetic changes.
- Version **5.3.0** — October 3rd 2015
 - Added “Application starter” item in the menu of the icon in the Notification Area.
 - Added case insensitive statistics.
 - Added statistics on the contents of the Clipboard of Windows.
 - Added a menu item to delete the contents of the multi-clipboard.
 - Enabled <Esc> key to close the global pop-up menu of the multi-clipboard.
 - Improved some default settings.
 - Bug fixed: some windows were not initialized if AAA is used in English.
- Version **5.2.0** — October 1st 2014
 - Added multi-clipboard.
 - Bug fixed: on first start-up of AAA some menu items were not initialized.
 - Bug fixed: clipboard history sometimes raised a (non-fatal) exception.
 - Bug fixed: statistics of pages containing only empty lines raised a (non-fatal) exception.
 - <Tab> key is now re-enabled in the text boxes.
 - Improved dictionary management.
 - Minor cosmetic changes.
- Version **5.1.2** — June 21st 2014
 - Added statistics on the selected text in the “Statistics” window.
 - Added a button to enable/disable alarms in the “Alarms” window.

- Added the number of active/total alarms in the “Alarms” menu item.
 - Improved the user interface for managing date and time in the “Alarms” window.
 - Minor cosmetic changes.
- Version **5.1.1** — June 13th, 2014
 - Added coordinates of the prompt.
 - Added a link to the licence in the “About AAA” window.
 - The messages of the alarms are now always in front of the other windows.
 - Bug fixed: if the message window of an alarm was not closed within one minute, the alarm was repeated and a (non-fatal) exception was raised.
 - Bug fixed: some shortcut key enabled autosave even though there were no changes.
 - Minor cosmetic changes.
 - Version **5.1.0** — March 20th, 2014
 - AAA is now a single instance application.
 - Added: automatic check for updates in the “About AAA” window.
 - Improved “Save” routine: now it is more efficient and nearly 50 times faster.
 - Bug fixed: alarms were inactive until the first click on AAA main menu.
 - Bug fixed: restoring backups did not work properly.
 - Bug fixed: some controls were wrongly placed if Windows font size was bigger than 100%.
 - Bug fixed: “Tab Swap” routines sometimes crashed AAA.
 - Bug fixed: /h and /? did not work properly.
 - <Tab> key is now enabled in the text boxes.
 - “Hide” menu item is now disabled when a modal form is shown.
 - Closing a modal form now keeps AAA in front of the other windows.

- Minor cosmetic changes.
- Version **5.0.0** — March 5th 2014
 - Rewritten from scratch with Visual Studio Express: added a few new features, removed a few old ones. AAA is a brand new application that does not support any more notepads saved with older versions.

- Version **1.0.0** — August 10th 1997
 - First public release.
