

Toolbar Revision History

This document contains details regarding improvements of the Toolbar FileMaker plug-in.

Toolbar version 1.0.4.28 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Improved: Toolbar is now compatible to FileMaker 12.
- Fixed: Script attached to a tab instead of a button could produce a crash. This has been addressed.

Toolbar version 1.0.3.25 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Improved: Added script caching facilities, which helps to improve the script starting speed.
- Improved: Added compatibility to '2empowerFM Developer Assistant' plug-in.

Toolbar version 1.0.2.22 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Improved: Toolbar buttons can be now aligned using the 'Justify' style, which can be used to resize all button lines to the width of the widest row.

Toolbar version 1.0.1.21 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Improved: Toolbar is now compatible to FileMaker 11.
- Improved: Toolbar can be attached to the specific database now, which means that Toolbar(s) will be displayed only when the necessary database is active.
- Improved: Toolbars may contain multiple lines now. Use a 'line-break' button type to make the next button move to the new line.
- Improved: To comply with the multiple lines concept, multi-line tabs and buttons can be by 'left', 'right', and 'center' aligned.
- Improved: Tab click can also active a script now, beside activating a particular Tab.
- Improved: Toolbar can be attached to any edge of the window (Windows) or screen (Mac OS X).
